Hocaro was born in July 2016 (on papers), but it is a project which really started in March 2016. It is a meeting between a robotics engineer and the president of a robotics company.

Cybedroïd, a robotics company from Limoges (France) is creating humanoid and half humanoid robots since more than 5 years at this time. Lucile Peuch is following them among their work and they decide to create a new company to create more business to their robots: Hocaro is shaping up.

Jacky Vauthier, president of the Hocaro company and of the group, take the lead of this new branch in Châlons en Champagne (headquarters of Hocaro in France).

In March 2017, Hocaro is quitting the group to deploy its activities and work parallelly on robots from a second company from Barcelona, Pal Robotics.

In September 2017, Hocaro creates its branding name Needabot to mark all the changes in Hocaro in the past year.
